

Conflicts of interest declaration for experts working with Mistra EviEM

To ensure the impartiality of its systematic reviews, Mistra EviEM asks the members of review teams to declare any conflicts of interest that may exist or arise during the review period.

A conflict of interest may occur when:

a member of the review team has, within the last five years, held employment with, undertaken an assignment for or received funds from a company or organisation engaged in the topic covered by the review.

If any of these circumstances apply, please declare the potential conflict of interest below:

An expert should not assess articles which he/she himself/herself has written, or articles written by close colleagues or relatives. If an expert encounters any article written by a close colleague or relative, this should be reported to the chair of the review team and the article should be assessed by another member of the team.
